The Studies of Chinese History, Shanghai University

The studies of Chinese History are an academic department at Shanghai University. In 2011, the studies of Chinese History offer the PhD degree on Chinese History. It has also established the Post-doc research center since 2012. The studies of Chinese History was nominated as the High Plateau Academic Research Program of Shanghai in 2015.

The studies of Chinese History are supported by over 25 academic staff, including 11 professors, 7 associate professors, and 7 assistant professors. The studies of Chinese History also included some titled staff, including one faculty supported by Program for New Century Excellent Talents in University, one faculty supported by Shanghai One Thousand Plan, one faculty supported by Pujiang Scholar Program, two faculties supported by the Shuguang Program. The studies of Chinese History is one of the very special places at Shanghai actively pursuing some specific aspects of Chinese history at Shanghai. Research at the studies of Chinese History covers Chinese Historical Literature and Philosophy, Archaeology and Cultural Heritage Management, Religion and Modern Chinese Societies, as Economic History of New China.

By the end of 2017, the studies of Chinese History has more than 44 projects won regular and substantial research funding from a wide range of national, or other provincial sources. There are four research projects supported by the Grand Program of the Chinese National Social Sciences Research Funding, including Theory and Method of the Origin of Chinese Civilization, collection and study of the bibliography of Chinese Christian Literature, c

Prof. LvJianchang, enrolled into the China National Library of Philosophy and Social Sciences. More than 30 articles and publications have been published and indexed by SSCI, A&HCI, and CSSCI.
